- **Migratory or seasonal farm workers** (or children of such workers) employed in meat packaging, field work, elevators, feedlots, dairies, or food processing, who are enrolled as freshmen
- **High School Diploma or GED** – (GPA 2.5 or above)
- **Complete FAFSA**
- **Be a U.S. Citizen or Legal Permanent Resident**
- **Enrolled or admitted for enrollment at GCCC**
