Issues:

- I. Minutes approved as amended.
- II. Gen Ed report (Chris): Only changes made to last year's processes are that we are only assessing all sophomores. This means policy may need to be changed. No matter what your major is, if a student is graduating from this institution they need to master all these essential skills. If a department wants to look at how sophomore majors are doing for their purposes, they can still do that. Brian mentioned that we as an institution want to move to a guided pathway approach. This means we should continue to look at sophomore majors. If we don't identify sophomore majors, we may lose department data. We need to be mindful of the policy. Chip mentioned assessing all sophomores will help give a better picture of what our General Education program is doing. Gen Ed committee will look at what courses are being offered, that will continue to assess the essential skills, and which courses need to be replaced on a case by case basis due to not being offered.
- III. Assessment on the LMS (Brian): Brian has been meeting with Jamie, Samantha was present during their last meeting. Gen Ed and SLAT needs to send their curriculum maps to Jamie. - VI. IEA office update: We are hiring a new person at the dean level. The president is in full support to re-staff this office. In the meantime, this office is being ran by Marc Malone. - VII. New Business: SLAT has been charged with completing the program review for LASC program. It will be modified from the regular program review since it is such a different program. The institution is looking at math reform and Dev Ed reform talks from KBOR.
