I. Gen Ed Report

The committee discussed the appropriateness of the value rubrics, specifically those focused on social responsibility and cultural diversity. As faculty utilize these rubrics they are encouraged to provide feedback to SLAT. Faculty are empowered to utilize rubrics in the context of the material and objectives of the class/assignments being assessed. It may be useful to promote among faculty a discussion focused on tailoring these value rubrics to our institution's use.

Gen Ed is requested to evaluate all sophomores against the Gen Ed program assessments.

Gen Ed is also being asked to consider whether the current five essential skills being utilized for the Gen Ed program assessment should be modified and how they may be assessed.
