- I. Minutes, Discussion: Approved as amended.
- II. Gen Ed Report (Chris, Seth): Gen Ed will be hosting an informative meeting to bring all faculty up to speed on the current state of Gen Ed assessment, terminology, and short-term/long-term plans.
