KBOR Reduction in Community College Degree Hours: 64 – 60:

Discussion includes a social science requirement composed of:

- AS: 9 hours of which PSYC101 and SOC102 must be taken
- AA: 9 hours of which PSYC101 and SOC102 must be taken
- AAS: 3 hours of which PSYC101 OR SOC102 must comprise the three hours
- AGS: 6 hours of which PSYC101 ~~OR~~ and SOC102 must comprise ~~three~~ six hours

Partial justification is the inclusion of the diversity and social responsibility essential skills into PSYC101 & SOC102 insuring that all graduates are exposed to these two essential skills.

Discussion of the math requirement composed of:

Renumbering MATH105 & MATH106 back to 000 numberings to accommodate financial aid requirements.

Discussion of the Physical Fitness requirement composed of:

Eliminating the two credit hour requirement for HPER
