

RE: DPAC Parking lot lights

It was determined that the DPAC parking lot lights have become a safety hazard. Two have fallen in high winds and fortunately no damage has occurred except to the asphalt. Since we have some dollars left in FY 08-09 we would like to replace all 6 lights before the baseball tournaments at the end of summer before school starts.

The bids include 6 30 foot poles (these are taller than before) with 3 lights on each pole. They are removing 4 poles and all 6 bases The bids a=re as follows:

- Replace existing pole bases with new concrete bases elevated at 36" above grade.

- Repair concrete walkways around pole
- Furnish and install six (6) new 30 ft round light poles dark bronze in color (see spec).
- Furnish 3 400W MH 277 V shoebox fixtures per pole (see spec).
