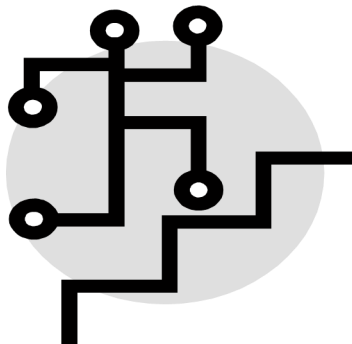

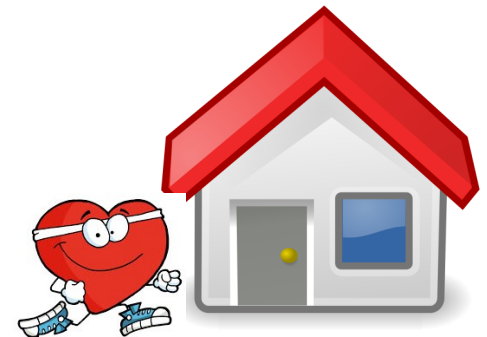

H.H.A. COURSE ENROLLMENT

**The following conditions must be met
prior to enrollment:**

1. Must be 16 y.o. and hold an active KS
C.N.A. Certificate.
2. Be able to provide proof of a **“negative”**
TB test that is not older than 1 year prior
to the start of class.
3. Nelson-Denny reading assessment. With a
score of 8 or higher.
 - * The Nelson-Denny is administered in the
Student Testing Center on Mondays or
Thursdays. Assessment will take approxi-
mately 45 minutes and is free of charge.
 - * Student must present a photo I.D. With-
out an I.D. student will not be allowed to
test.
 - * For testing times and information call:
620-276-9560
 - * You will be given a score sheet upon
completion of the assessment which you
will need to bring with you to enroll.
3. Once you have completed the Nelson-
Denny assessment you will take the score
sheet, Social Security card & Photo ID to the
nursing Dept. in the Penka Building to com-
plete enrollment for the H.H.A. Program.

H.H.A. (ONLINE) COURSE DESCRIPTION

The course is completely online and
consists of a minimum of 20 clock
class hours to prepare the student to
provide patient care in the home.

The course includes basic knowledge
and skills necessary to help meet the
psychosocial, physical and environmen-
tal needs of clients still residing in the
home.

The H.H.A. is prepared to give patient
care under the supervision of a regis-
tered nurse, licensed practical nurse
or physician.

The course will qualify the student to
take the Kansas State H.H.A. Certifica-
tion Examination. After passing the
State Exam, the H.H.A. is qualified for
employment with Home Health Agen-
cies as well as other health care facul-
ties who provide in home care.

Enrollment for each H.H.A. class will be on a first-come, first-served basis.
