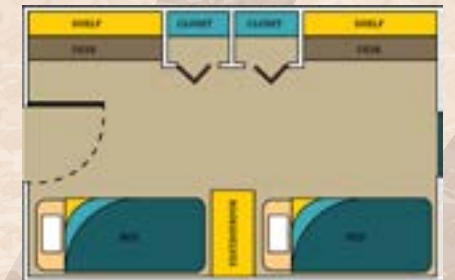

Financial Aid

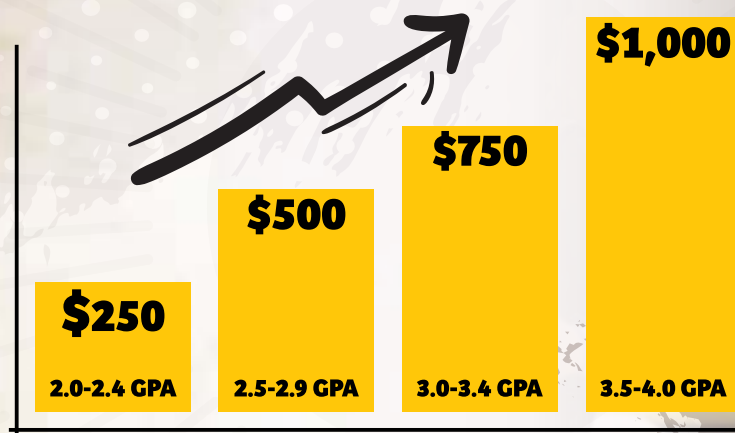
From scholarships and federal aid to on-campus programs our friendly, knowledgeable Financial Aid staff is available to help students find ways to pay for their education.

- **ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS**

Awards are based on high school or college G.P.A. It pays to have good grades! LITERALLY.



- **ACTIVITY SCHOLARSHIPS**

Many programs, activities, & clubs offer scholarships for participation. Interested students should contact activity and club sponsors for scholarship availability.



- **INSTITUTIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS**

FEDERAL FINANCIAL AID - FAFSA

Federal Pell grants and Federal loans are available to eligible students. Student eligibility is based on financial need determined by the U.S. Department of Education and reviewed by the United States Congress annually.

- **FEDERAL PELL GRANTS** do not have to be repaid. Grants range in size according to student eligibility and the student's level of enrollment.
- **SUBSIDIZED AND UNSUBSIDIZED FEDERAL LOANS** have to be repaid once the student completes their degree or certificate or if the student drops out.

OTHER WAYS TO PAY FOR COLLEGE

There are many programs on campus that allow students to earn scholarships or even a paycheck.

- **TUTORING**

Become a paid tutor for the Comprehensive Learning Center (CLC) or STEM.



- **WORK-STUDY**

Work-study programs are available for students to work on campus around their class schedule.

- **PRESIDENTIAL AMBASSADOR**

Students can be a Presidential Ambassador and represent GCCC at events and activities - and maybe even be featured in a GCCC commercial! Speak to your high school counselor for more details.

- **LOCAL SCHOLARSHIPS**

Check for off-campus scholarships in your community. Churches, foundations, and other local organizations often provide scholarships for local students.

- **CAMP & TRIO-SSS PROGRAMS**

Check out on-campus programs like CAMP and TRIO Student Support Services (SSS) that can earn you a scholarship.



- **KANSAS PROMISE SCHOLARSHIP**

This scholarship is a last dollar scholarship, which means that a student may receive a scholarship for the amount financial aid did not cover. Students can choose a Kansas Promise Scholarship eligible program and receive a scholarship for their remaining balance after any other financial aid has been applied.
